## Ozark Trails Council Facilities Use Agreement Effective January 1, 2012

All reservations of Council Facilities must be made through the Council Program Coordinator at the Springfield Service Center - (417) 883-1636 ext. 238

Camp facilities are not available during resident camp seasons. Certain facilities are use restricted, please contact the Council Program Coordinator for facilities not listed to inquire about their use.

A joint inspection will be conducted with the facility manager and agreement made on any missing or damaged property, standards of cleanliness and any additional requirements both parties may have, before and after use. The unit/group shall be responsible for any and all damages (excepting normal wear and tear) to Council property which may reasonably be attributed to the actions of said unit/group. Said unit/group agrees to promptly pay any and all reasonable damage claims when presented. No structure, attachments or furnishings are to be moved without permission

Units/groups staying overnight must provide their own tents, bedding, and cots. If using a property with cabins, own bedding and in some situations cots, must be provided by renting parties. Sleeping quarters are to be separated in accordance with National BSA Youth Protection guidelines.

No smoking in or around any council owned buildings or structures, and only in posted / designated areas in camp grounds. No alcohol or drugs, personal firearms, pets or pornography are allowed on Boy Scout Property

There are no trash cans or trash pickup to Cow Creek, Plagens, Timmons, or Sproat Properties. Each group is responsible for removing and disposing of all trash from these properties. Please check with the Rangers at Camp Arrowhead and Frank Childress Scout Reservation about the proper way of disposing of trash prior to departure from the property.

Use of the repelling/climbing tower, or COPE course requires the approval of the OTC Camping Committee and must have authorized directors/instructors with valid BSA regional certification, including documentation that an additional adult member over 18 is BSA or Red Cross CPR certified.

Use of Table Rock Lake at Cow Creek requires approval and must have documentation of certification in BSA Safe Swim Defense and adult CPR for one adult over 21, including documentation that an additional adult or older youth member is BSA Aquatics Supervision: Swimming and Water Rescue or BSA or Red Cross lifeguard certified.

Use of Council swimming pool requires OTC Camping Committee approval and must have documentation of certification in BSA Safe Swim Defense and adult CPR for one adult over 21 including documentation that an additional adult or older youth member is BSA Aquatics Supervision: Swimming and Water Rescue or BSA or Red Cross lifeguard certified.

Use of canoes and boats on council property requires the Scout unit submit documentation that an adult leader over 21 is certified in BSA Safe Swim Defense and adult CPR, including documentation that an additional adult or older youth member is BSA Aquatics Supervision: Swimming and Water Rescue or BSA or Red Cross lifeguard certified to be placed on file in the Council office. Use of canoes off council property additionally requires a BSA Float Plan be submitted for BSA Units and is not allowed for Non-Scout groups. Row boats are not for use off council property. For required complete boating safety procedures, refer to the BSA Guide to Safe Scouting 2010 revision, Chapter II Aquatics Safety, Safety Afloat Section, pages 11 - 14.

The unit/group will provide one adult leader 21 years of age or older and one adult leader 18 years of age or older for the first ten members of the unit/group present in the facility below 21 years of age and at least one additional adult leader 21 years or older for each additional ten members of the unit/group below 21 years. One adult leader 21 years or older must be present with the unit/group at all times. There must be an adult leader of the same sex or sexes in this same porportion if the unit/group is coed.

If the unit/group fails to provide leadership or to abide by Council rules or directions of Camp Ranger, the Camp Ranger may, at their sole discretion, terminate this agreement and require the unit/group to immediately vacate Council property, forfeiting any and all fees and monies.

Non-Scout Groups must submit a certificate of liability insurance with a minimum of \$2,000,000.00 CSL with the Ozark Trails Council, Inc. the Boy Scouts of America, named as additional insured, ten day written notice of cancellation, and the period of time involved, must be provided in advance to the Council office. Out-of-Council Boy Scout units must submit a copy of their council insurance.

The unit/group (hereinafter referred to as the "Indemnitor") hereby agrees, to the fullest extent permitted by law, to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Boy Scouts of America, its chartered affiliates, agents, servants, employees, officers and directors (hereinafter individually and collectively referred to as "Indemnitees") from all suits, claims, demands, actions, or proceedings from all liability, loss, damage, claims, demands, costs, and expenses of whatever nature, including in part, court costs and attorney fees, based upon any personal injury, act, omission, or occurrence of Indemnitor or any person or organization for whom Indemnitor may be responsible, arising out of, in connection with, resulting from, or caused by the Indemnitor's use of real or personal property belonging to Indemnitees, regardless, of whether or not caused in part by a party indemnified hereunder.

Additionally, Indemnitor agrees to limit the Indemnitees' liability to Indemnitor for any loss or damage, including, but not limited to, special and consequential damages due to any of the Indemnitees' acts, errors or omission, strict liability, breach of contract or breach of warranty; such that the total aggregate liability of the Indemnitees to the Indemnitor shall not exceed the total fees paid by the Indemnitees for the use of real or personal property belonging to Indemnitees. It is agreed and understood that such amount shall be the sole and exclusive remedy to Indemnitor as a result of said liability of Indemnitees.

Boy Scouts of America units must submit a tour plan at least 21 days before the date of the activity if participating in any aquatic, climbing, C.O.P.E., or shooting sports activities to allow for authorization and return of same to the unit leader. Any out of council unit must provide an approved tour plan from their own council, and other documents as required. All units/groups must submit any required payment and proof of insurance at time of reservation. Payment in full must be received at time of reservation.

This agreement is between the Ozark Trails Council, Boy Scouts of America and the Unit/Group stated on the front of this form, and is for the purpose of establishing the use of Council property by the Unit/Group.
