



# 2010 OZARK TRAILS CAMPORALL

**Honoring our past.....  
..... building our future.**

**October 1, 2, 3, 2010**

**What:** 2010 Ozark Trails Camporall “Honoring our past... building our future”

**When:** October 1-3, 2010

**Where:** 3825 W. Farm Road 146. Springfield, MO 65802 (see map)

**Who can come:** All registered Scouts and Scouters. Cub scouts may attend as Saturday ‘day visitors’ only. All units attending will need to register by September 17, 2010 at the Springfield Service Center, Rolla Scout Shop or Joplin Scout Shop. Units will NOT be allowed to register after September 17, 2010.

**Cost for Troops, Teams, Crews, Posts:** \$15 per person before September 17, 2010. Any individual added to the roster at event check-in will \$20.

**Cost for Packs:** Saturday ‘day visitors’ (i.e. Cub Scouts) will cost is \$10 before September 17, 2010. All individual added to the roster at event check in will be \$15.

**Check in:** Will begin at 4pm on Friday October 1, 2010

**Tour permits:** Are required for all units. Any unit without a tour permit will be denied entry.

**Unit Roster:** A roster listing both youth and adults must be turned in along with registration. In addition you will need a copy when you check in.

**Leadership:** In accordance with BSA policies “a minimum of two registered adults must provide leadership to their unit at all times and at least one must be 21 years of age or older.” All units must have two-deep leadership for the entire weekend.

**Uniform:** The scout uniform is appropriate for any scouting activity. However; it is requested that class A uniforms be worn at morning and evening flags and Saturday night's campfire.

**Water:** Water will be available for units to fill their own containers. However, it is recommended that they bring enough water to get through Friday night as the delivery of water may be hindered by units checking in and delivering gear to campsites.

**Fires:** Absolutely no ground fires are allowed, no exceptions. If possible only use camp stoves as even charcoal fires are discouraged. Any off the ground fire pits must be attended at all times and be dead out before the unit leaves the campsite for any reason.

**Latrines:** There will be portable toilets for use in site. Some of these will be labeled women and some will be for handicapped use only. Please respect this. Be prepared and bring your own toilet paper as we expect a large crowd. Please help us and do not dispose of trash or any other items in these. In addition help keep them clean.

**Parking:** Vehicles will be used to transport gear to the campsites only. Only unit trailers may be left in campsites NO VEHICLES.

**Meals:** All units, including Saturday 'day visitors' will be responsible for their own meals. Carry in meals that can be left in vehicles until needed are recommended for Packs.

**This is a "Green" campout:** All units are asked to use plates and cups that are not disposable. In addition, units are asked to use towels and wash rags that are not disposable. We will be providing bio-degradable soap (but units must bring their own empty container/bottle for the soap). There will be a gray water

disposal area for all units. Trash service will not be provided so units should plan to 'pack out the trash'.

### **General Camp Rules:**

- ~All fuels, stoves, and lanterns will be used in accordance with BSA safety policies.
- ~Never play with a knife.
- ~No pets allowed at Camporall
- ~Do not apply insect repellents near source of flame.
- ~Keep latrines clean. Everyone has to use them.
- ~No one can be transported in the cargo section of any vehicle or in any trailer.
- ~We will be camping very close be respectful of your neighbors.
- ~DO NOT cut through campsites. Stay out of campsites not your own.
- ~All rules pertaining to Youth Protection are in effect and will be enforced.
- ~All units will be required to check out with commissioners.
- ~BSA policies pertaining to alcohol, tobacco, and any other substances will be adhered to.
- ~Live trees will not be damaged for any reason. There is no reason to gather wood as wood fires are not allowed.
- ~All scouts and scouters will abide and live by the scout oath and laws.
