**No District Meetings in July**

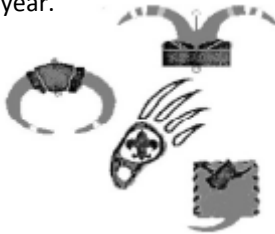
