

ROLLA MERIT BADGE UNIVERSITY 2010

When? February 20, 2010. Merit Badge day is from 8:30 A.M to 4:30 P.M.

Where? Sign-in and assembly will be in the St Pat's Ballroom on the 2nd floor of the Havener Center (Bldg. 50), located on the SE corner of University Drive (Hwy E) and Bishop (US Hwy 63), of the Missouri University of Science & Technology in Rolla. Take the Hwy E exit off of I-44. Park in areas V, B, or H. Use the pedestrian underpass to cross Bishop. Sign-in starts at 8 AM.

Cost? \$6.00 per Scout if registered by Feb. 8 Fee includes patches, merit badge cards, and supplies needed for the classes. Send registration to: Rolla Service Center, 612 Pine St., Suite 103, Rolla, MO 65401-3187. Checks should be made out to Ozark Trails Council BSA, and should accompany your registration. Paperwork must be **received** at the office by Feb. 8. If there are any openings after the registration deadline of **Feb. 8**, the fee will be \$12.00. We do not expect to be able to handle walk-ins!

Study the requirements ahead of time. Bring reference materials. Items completed ahead of time should be brought to MBU or certified by the Scoutmaster ahead of time. Partials will be given for work that is incomplete. If a Scout gets a partial, it is up to the Scoutmaster or Advancement Chairman to make sure the Scout finishes all the requirements properly. You will be notified when your registration is filed and which merit badge your Scouts have been assigned to. **If at all possible give an e-mail address.**

Print legibly.

Notes For Scoutmasters:

- ***Each Scout should bring his own lunch** as not all sessions are held at Missouri S&T and not all sessions are close to an eating establishment. Troops will not be able to get together for lunch since all sessions break at different times.
- *Scouts and Scouters should be in uniform and abide by the Scout Oath and Law.
- *Leaders are required on a ratio of one per five boys to help out in the classes, transit areas, and with transportation.
- *Adults will be assigned specific duties. Every attempt will be made to keep adults with their units. Adults **MUST** participate as monitors, or in any other needed function, so that this may be a success for our youth.
- *When you send in your registration, please let us know who is driving as well as the type and capacity of the vehicle(s) they are driving so we can match it with transportation requirements for the boys.
- *You will be required to show a tour permit when you arrive and when you pick up your patches.
- *Each Scout should bring a pencil and paper for taking notes, etc. Merit Badge Pamphlets will NOT be available for sale at MBU so plan to obtain the necessary pamphlets for your boys prior to arrival at MBU.
- *Scouts need to dress appropriately for the weather, as many sessions will involve outdoor activity.
- *Boys **MUST** have been active in the Troop for at least three months prior to the Merit Badge University.

All registration forms are to be sent in as soon as possible so that we can fill as many spots as possible. First come first served.
